Board Elections/Officers Appointed

The board and administration congratulated both Marcus Fricke and Justin Boege on being re-elected to the Collins-Maxwell School Board. The board appointed Marcus and Bryce to continue serving in the capacity of Board President and Board Vice-President, respectively.

Security Cameras

Mr. Grandon presented a proposal to purchase **additional security cameras** for the Collins Elementary in addition to an **entrance Intercom system**. The two additional cameras will be placed in the Gym and the back of the building, overlooking the playground. The board approved the purchase and thanked Mr. Grandon for his **continued focus on student safety**.

Revised Eligibility Plan Coming Soon

Mr. Nelson presented an updated eligibility proposal to the Board which basically changes the eligibility review period from end-of-semester to a **weekly review**. The proposed updates to the eligibility policy are being made to put more emphasis on the classroom, valuing continuous academic progress, and maintaining good academic standing. The current policy, in many ways, is seen as punitive and disciplinary. In the October meeting, the board will review the updated policy and take action to adopt the proposed changes.
