“Little Spartan Summer Camp”

The board approved to extend the elementary summer enrichment program, partnering with YSS and United Way, for this upcoming summer. Last year over 100 children participated in the program with over 3300 meals being provided. The program is focused on ensuring youth achieve literacy proficiency levels by providing meaningful opportunities for learning and preventing summer learning loss. The program has three primary goals:

- Youth will maintain/show growth in literacy over the summer
- The meal gaps for youth is addressed by providing free breakfast and lunch every day of the program
- Social skills and community engagement are boosted through safe and positive experiences with adult role models and parents.

Music Memorial Donation

The music department received a generous donation in memory of Lois French Olson, class of 1950. Over \$1000 has been provided and will be used to purchase a set of classroom guitars for general music and potentially a guitar club after school.
